# Vehicle specific console for 2025 Ford Mustang Mach E



## **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

Installing keyless entry sensors in correct locations is important. Rear OEM sensor mounts inside console housing on driver side using holes and hardware provided. Front OEM sensor mounts inside console on top of air duct. Holes must be drilled in plastic air duct and mount using hardware provided. See photos on last page.

View of Mustang Mach E prior to install




Unsnap and remove top of center storage area.




Remove all remaining modules and harness from lower center storage area



Remove front OEM console by gently pulling up from the front.



Unscrew wireless phone charger from underside of center storage area.



Remove (4) OEM fasteners from rear of lower, center storage area.





Unsnap trim from upper section or lower, center storage area and remove (4) OEM fasteners.



Remove forward panel and lower center storage area.




Remove all OEM center console parts. Save hardware for possible future use.




Attach the front mounting bracket 25616 using previously removed OEM fasteners.





Attach front side brackets to OEM frame under dash with previously removed OEM fasteners.

(Passenger side bracket is slightly longer and has larger offset)



Attach rear brackets to OEM brackets using previously removed OEM fasteners. Attach cross support to rear brackets with 1/4" x 1/2" carriage bolts and nuts. This must be done before installing console housing in order to access OEM bracket hardware.








Place console housing into vehicle by sliding in from rear. Attach housing to front center bracket with 1/4" x 1/2" carriage bolts and nuts.

(Two bolts and nuts each side)




Attach rear housing sides to rear brackets with 1/4" x 1/2" carriage bolts and nuts.

(Four bolts and nuts each side)




Attach brake switch holder to face plate with #8-18 X 3/8 flat head screws. Insert Hazard switch into face plate and plug in wiring.



Attach front housing sides to front side brackets with 1/4" x 1/2" carriage bolts and nuts.

(One bolt and nut each side)



Attach brake switch to holder with 10-32 x 1/2" screws and nuts.



Place OEM wireless charger into rear of charger faceplate and bracket. Attach adaptor bracket with  $10-32 \times 1/2$ " screws to hold charger in.

Install charger bracket and parking brake plate assemblies into console.



Attach Rear OEM Key sensor inside console housing with 10-32 x 1/2" screw and nut and plug in wiring.



Position and attach front OEM Key sensor side to side inside console on top of air duct with 10-32 x 1/2" screw and nut.

Drilling plastic dust required. Insert foam into vent to prevent air from blowing inside console.



Install passenger side trim panel with three (3) #8-18 X 3/8 flat head screws.



Driver side trim panel.

Loosely install previously removed OEM bolt into frame under dash. Then place trim panel slotted hole under bolt head. Attach the three (3) #8-18 X 3/8 flat head screws then tighten OEM bolt.



Install equipment as desired to complete installation.
