




- there is enough length to pass through the column, the two clamp plates B and the nut J.
- Position previous made assembly against the column ensuring the rubber is against the column. If the column is 2-4" wide, the mounting blocks are oriented as shown in the instructions. If the column is 1-2" wide, the mounting blocks should be rotated 90°.
- 3 Slide the appropriate size clamp bolt (C, D or E) through the assembly and the second clamp plate B. Secure with loosely with nut J. Note if the assembly is getting in the way the knob can be loosened to allow some movement of the assembly.
- 4 Attach the other 3 bolts (C, D or E) as above securing with nut J. Ensure bolts are as close to the column as possible before tightening. Once all bolts have been attached, the locknuts can be fully tightened. If extra thread protrudes from nut, cover threads using rubber caps K, 4x.





4 Once screws are fully tightened readjust the knob and position

as desired.






Installation 2

- Select the appropriate size clamp bolt C, D or E ensuring that there is enough length to pass through the column, the two clamp plates B and the nut J.
- 2 Position previous made assembly against the column ensuring the rubber is against the column. If the column is 2-4" wide, the mounting blocks are oriented as shown in the instructions. If the column is 1-2" wide, the mounting blocks should be rotated 90°.
- 3 Slide the appropriate size clamp bolt (C, D or E) through the assembly and the second clamp plate B. Secure with loosely with nut J. Note if the assembly is getting in the way the knob can be loosened to allow some movement of the assembly.
- 4 Attach the other 3 bolts (C, D or E) as above securing with nut J. Ensure bolts are as close to the column as possible before tightening. Once all bolts have been attached, the locknuts can be fully tightened. If extra thread protrudes from nut, cover threads using rubber caps K, 4x.
